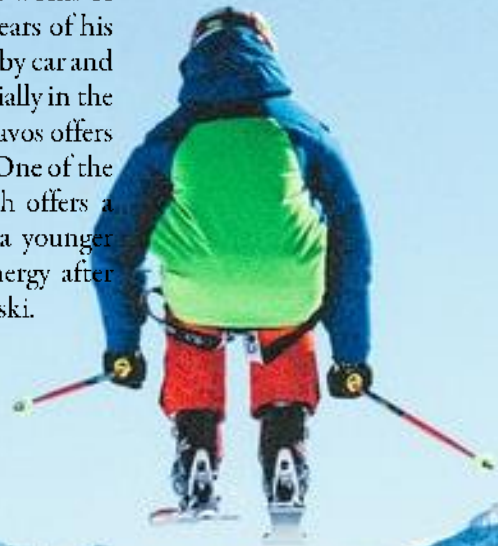

# Skiing in Davos

# A Russian Christmas

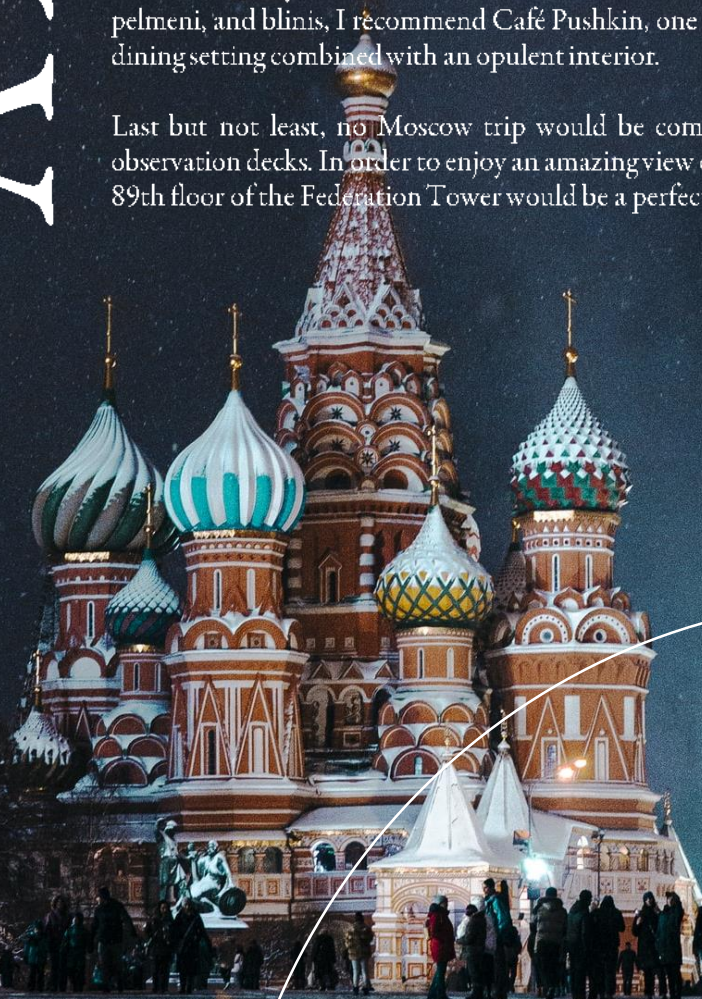
