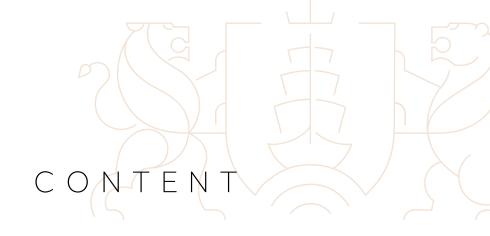

CONVERSATION WITH OUR CEO, DR PETER RASKIN

Reflecting on the past year, what do you consider the bank's most significant achievement?

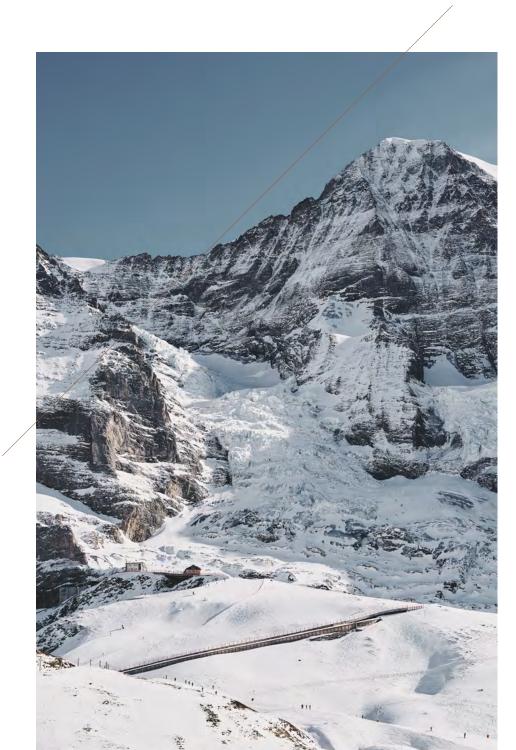
Looking ahead, what are your priorities for the bank in the ESG space over the next year?

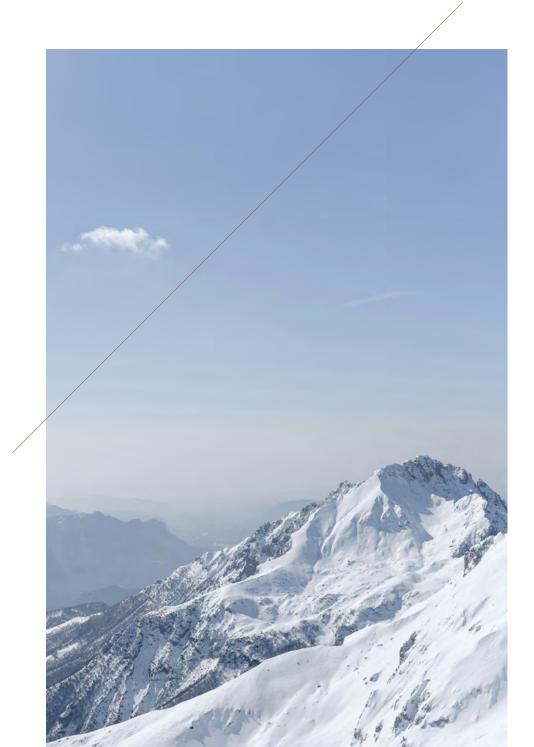

We are a Swiss Private Bank located in the breathtaking natural landscapes and resources of Switzerland surrounding us. We recognize our share of responsibility in protecting our environment – in this chapter, we share the actions we put in place in 2024 to minimize our carbon footprint and support sustainable practices internally.

Achieved in 2024

Further digitalization of processes contributing to a steady decrease in paper usage.

New environmental initiative to raise employee awareness with the Bergos Step-Up Challenge: 50% of the employees participated in small teams to collect an average of 8,000 steps per person per day. This challenge helped change our employees' commuting habits, but also boosted health activities and contributed to a team spirit across the bank.

Offset of our business travel emissions (both transport and accommodation) in 2024.

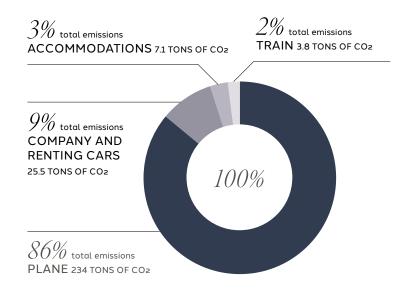

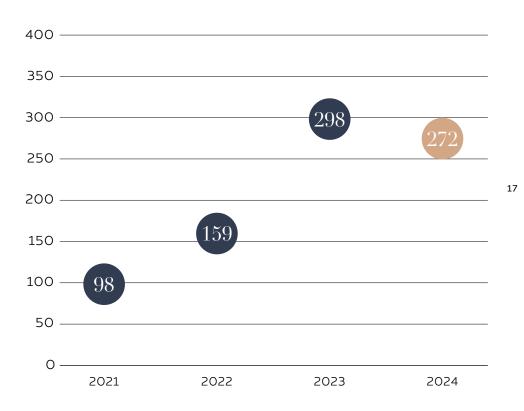

To minimize our environmental impact, we take special care in prioritizing the most eco-friendly transportation and accommodation options. We are proud to report that in 2024, we significantly reduced air travel in favor of rail transportation, contributing to a substantial 8.5%* reduction in our total CO2 emissions.

Recognizing that some emissions are unavoidable, we partner with MyClimate to offset our remaining carbon footprint by supporting clean energy projects around the world.

° Philanthropic Engagement

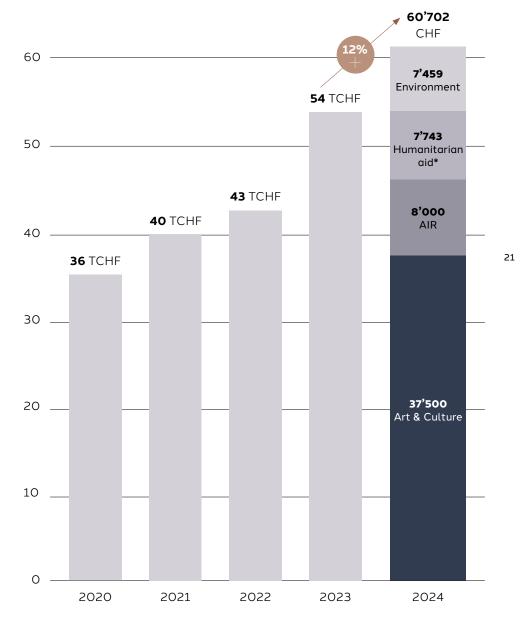

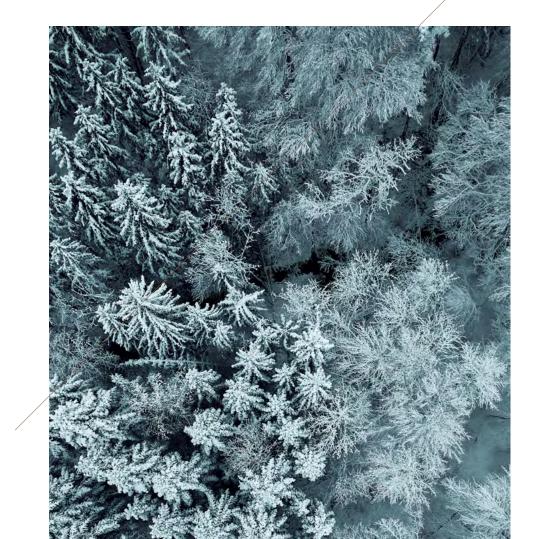

Living our Core Values

RECOGNIZING EXCELLENCE

We value the hard work and achievements of our Bergosians. In 2024, 16% of our full-time employees were promoted, reflecting our commitment to reward excellence and encourage career growth. We recognize the talent of our young professionals, offering them leading functions from an early stage on.

PROMOTING LIFELONG LEARNING

We are committed to fostering a culture of continuous learning by offering our employees access to a wide range of certifications and online courses. In 2024, we expanded our online training options on the Swiss Learning Hub. In addition, we offered various hybrid learning formats to develop employees' skills in using artificial intelligence, enabling our teams to remain agile and excel in a rapidly evolving work environment.

CHAMPIONING EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

We are proud to be an inclusive workplace, where we value humans beyond gender. Since 2024, our contracts and relevant guidelines are gender-neutral. Dedicated to supporting new parents, Bergos offers a paternity leave of up to 14 weeks, matching the maternity leave, and flexible part-time work models to ease the transition back into the office. These efforts highlight our modern vision of gender, family dynamics, and work-life balance.

Fostering an Inclusive and Supportive Culture

EMPOWERING WOMEN

Through our Bergos Women Network, we have created a platform for our female employees to connect, learn, and grow. In 2024, we organized 6 Ladies' Lunches, a variety of sports sessions, and a networking event featuring inspiring speakers, all aimed at empowering women across our organization and beyond. In 2024, the share of female employees, measured in full-time equivalents, stands at 38%, highlighting the significant impact of ongoing efforts to promote gender diversity.

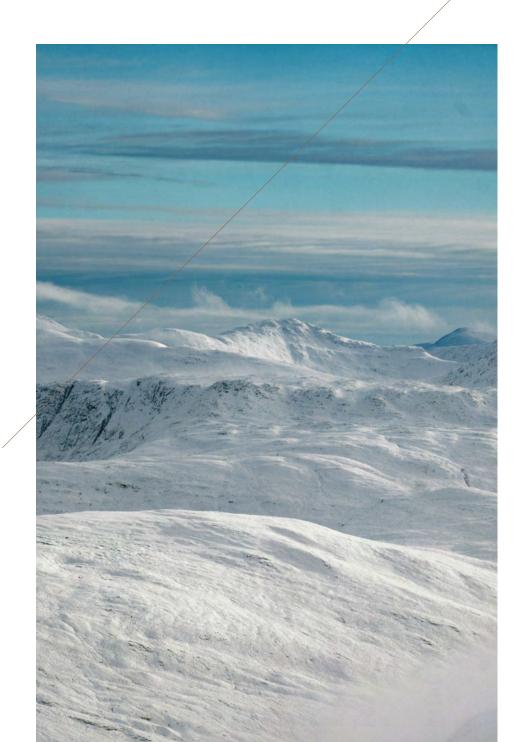

STRENGTHENING OF OUR ESG EXPERTISE

As ESG considerations become more central to investment decision-making, we continuously strive to strengthen our in-house expertise. In 2024, our ESG Investments Team further deepened its **knowledge** through specialized ESG courses and certifications, ensuring they effectively navigate the evolving sustainable investing landscape. Additionally, our investment professionals receive regular dedicated training on our in-house ESG framework and approach, strengthening our ability to consistently apply it in investment advice and decisions, and thereby better support our clients in aligning their investments with their values.

ENHANCING OUR ESG OFFERING

We are steadily enhancing our ESG investment solutions to better serve our clients' evolving needs.

In 2024, we continued expanding the quality and reach of our ESG offering by integrating ESG factors more comprehensively into our discretionary services. We have continued to improve our proprietary ESG scoring framework by incorporating new insights and refinements to better assess ESG risks, opportunities, and potential impacts, and have expanded it to new asset classes (e.g. liquid alternatives).

LAUNCHING OUR PHILANTHROPIC OFFERING
